

Tariff & Charges sheet 2018

The details contained in the Tariff sheet are purely to inform you of Paylight's tariffs and charges. Under no circumstance should the tariff sheet be regarded as an amendment of any agreements with Paylight. No representation or warranty is given regarding the accuracy of any information contained in the tariff sheet. Paylight accordingly disclaims any and all liability resulting from the use or reliance on the information contained in the Tariff sheet.

Paylight provides electricity in discrete amounts and charges are based on individual transactions. This improves planning for customers and decreases electricity unavailability issues. Where applicable, charges are inclusive of VAT.

Definitions

Energy supplier charge: The rate in R/kWh that Eskom, the Municipality, or the relevant power producer or distributor generates active and reactive power. Firstly this is based on the landrate of the consumer and secondly this charge does increase and decrease with differing landrates, electricity usage and peak consumption, however Paylight incurs the cost for the purpose of issuing discrete voucher amounts and to give customers terms not less favorable then the relevant power producer or distributor.

Administration charge: The fixed charge payable per point of delivery to recover administration-related costs such as meter calibration and maintenance of basic Paylight property. It is based on the number of connected users, and averaged across the individual monthly utilised capacity to cater for non-use periods. This charge is not subject to the Resale Tariff (NERSA-467-58 par 8.4).

Digital reliability charge: The charge that recovers the cost of providing services to fulfill our contract with the customer by Paylight. This includes custom SMSes, flexible payments, customer conveniences, Secure Socket Layer security, Email, telephonic and online electricity vouchers. This places the customer in a position more favorable than the relevant power producer or distributor.
